

2018 CICCS QUALIFICATIONS GUIDE



- The CICCIS Qualifications Guide went into effect July 1, 2018.
- Anyone initiating a Position Task Book (PTB) after July 1, 2018 will be using this version of the CICCIS Qualifications Guide.



2018 CICCIS

Required Recurrent Training:

- RT-130 Annual Fireline Safety Refresher
- RT-378 Air Tactical Group Supervisor Refresher
- A-110 Triennial Hazardous Materials Training
- HRSP Refresher
- Agency Determined Training



“Trainee status begins when the position initiation and certification is completed by the training officer and the employee is entered into ROSS in that ICS position.”

1. Peer review approval/certification
2. Properly initiated PTB
3. Trainee status added to qualifications in ROSS



2018 CIGCS

- PTBs for Air Operations and Expanded Dispatch positions must be completed within 3 years.
- PTBs for all other positions must be completed within 5 years.



2018 CIGCS

With concurrence of the appropriate Peer Review Committee, the Chief Administrator or their Designee may grant an extension to the completion of a PTB.

- Extensions will be granted in 1-year increments, to a maximum of 5.
- PTBs not completed within the specified timeframes may require an individual to meet the current adopted training and experience qualification standard.



A minimum of two quality assignments is required for an applicant to be considered for certification.

- Quality assignments exercise the full range of responsibilities of the assigned trainee positions.
- Peer Review Committees should evaluate each application based on the complexity of the assignments submitted for certification.
- All hazard incidents shall be considered when evaluating applications for certification.



2018 CIGCS

These positions are now reviewed by the Operational Area Peer Review Committee:

- Damage Inspection Specialist (DINS)
- Damage Inspection Manager (DINM)
- Fire Line EMT (EMTF)
- Fire Line Paramedic (EMPF)
- Task Force Leader Water Handling (TFWH)



Position Requirements

I-300 is **now required** for:

- STEN, STCR, TEQ, TFLD, THWH, DIVS, SITL, RESL, DOCL, MEDL, COML, FDUL, FACL, GSUL, COST, COMP, and PROC.

I-300 is **no longer required** for:

- ENGB, FIRB, FELB, HMGB, HEQB, and ABRO.



2018 CIGCS

Command Changes

- S-300 is an alternative to G/E/L 950 for ICT3.
- S-400 is no longer a recognized course by NWCG.
- ICT5 is no longer a position in CICCS.
- All-Hazards Safety Officer (SOF3) is not reciprocal with Safety Officer, Line (SOFR).
- HRSP is moved from Plans to Command.



2018 CICCS

Operations Changes

- S-336 is replaced by N-9025 Tactical Decisions and Sand Tables.
- Ignition Operations S-234 is replaced by S-219.
- I-400 is added to the training requirements for OPBD.
- New position: Task Force Leader Water Handling (TFWH), is a concurrent qualification with Strike Team Leader, Engine (STEN).



2018 CIGCS

Operations Changes

- Dozer Boss (S-232) is replaced by Heavy Equipment Boss (S-236).
- Engine Boss, Single Resource [ENGB] training requirements are changed to:

Wildland Training for Structural Firefighters (G-231)

OR

Fire Operations in the Wildland Urban Interface (S-215)

Crew Boss (Single Resource) (S-230)

Engine Boss (Single Resource) (S-231)

Intermediate Wildland Fire Behavior (S-290)



2018 CIGCS

Air Operations Changes

- Helicopter Manager Type 1 (HEB1) changes from 4+ Aircraft to 6+ Aircraft.
- Helicopter Manager Type 2 (HEB2) changes from 1-3 Aircraft to 1-5 Aircraft.
